

# Welcome to North Road Chapel

Public services are resuming in the Chapel from July 2020. For the benefit of all who attended, please observe the following measures:

**Hygiene:** Please make use of alcohol gel provided in the entrance lobby, and toilet facilities upon arrival. Avoid unnecessary contact with door handles and other surfaces. Face masks are also provided for those who wish to use them.

**Social Distancing:** Please maintain approximately 2m (6 ft) distance between yourself and other attendees (except those in your own household / family group).

Please sit where directed by the Door Steward, leaving one vacant pew between yourself (or your household / family group) and adjacent attenders.

Please avoid congregating in the entrance lobby and aisles. For fellowship and conversation after the service, make use of the main hall or the car park where more space is available.

**Shared Bibles and Hymnbooks:** Books are provided at your seat. If you are joining us for both Sunday services, please make use of the same books morning and evening. Affix a post-it note to identify them. If you are attending one service only, please place your used books on the pew cushion when leaving for ease of collection.

**Children:** Please ensure that young children in your household / family group also observe the measures described.

**Symptoms and Contact Tracing:** Please do not attend the services if you, or a member of your household / family group, are unwell. If you, or someone with whom you have contact develops symptoms, or returns a positive test result within seven days of attending a service, please notify one of the church officers as soon as possible: Mr D. C. Wort (01237 471233), or Mr R. J. Steward (01237 239430). We request any visitors who are unknown to us to provide us with your name and a contact number before leaving.

**Vulnerable People:** If you belong to a clinically vulnerable category, please take extra care when attending. Persons in the 'extremely vulnerable' / 'shielding' category should not attend.

**Future Arrangements:** Changes in Government guidance may necessitate an alteration to these arrangements in the future. Please listen to notices, check the website, or contact the church officers.
